GETTING AROUND

RENTAL CARS, LIMOS, BUS, TAXIS & RIDESHARE



Rideshare options like **Uber** and **Lyft**, as well as several taxi companies, are a convenient way for visitors to get around the destination.

Or make a reservation for a limo to pick you up in style.

If you'd prefer your own vehicle, **the Harry Reid International Airport Rental Car Center is open 24 hours a day, 365 days a year**.

Shuttles and buses are easily accessible in Vegas, and The Deuce on the Strip stops at nearly every resort on the Strip, while DVX runs through Downtown and Fremont Street. Additionally, the **Downtown Loop is a free shuttle in Downtown Las Vegas**, including the Arts District and Fremont Street Experience.

LAS VEGAS MONORAIL



The 3.9-mile elevated monorail conveniently navigates the Las Vegas Strip in less than 15-minutes at speeds of up to 50 mph. Mobile tickets and several fare types are available to suit your travel needs.

VEGAS LOOP AT LAS VEGAS CONVENTION CENTER

The Vegas Loop at Las Vegas Convention Center provides fast and convenient transportation for convention and trade show attendees across the LVCC campus, connecting the West Hall with the existing campus (North/Central/South Halls).

Five passenger stations (see map below) offer convenient access between key LVCC destinations and nearby transportation connections, such as the Las Vegas Monorail. Current Vegas Loop public stations include Resorts World Las Vegas, Westgate Las Vegas Resort & Casino and Encore Resort at Wynn.

Typical walk time between the West Hall to the existing North/Central Halls can take up to 25 minutes. The same trip on the Vegas Loop at Las Vegas Convention Center takes approximately 2 minutes.

Free On-Campus Rides

Travel within the Las Vegas Convention Center campus is fast, fun, and free of charge.
